Role

The role of the Kids Ministry Resident will serve along side the Kids Pastor in overseeing all areas of Kids Ministry (birth-5th grade). Kids Ministry also ministers to parents to help build strong families in our community.

- A primary focus will be to develop and implement a connection strategy for new and current families. This would include a first time guest follow up plan and track missing families to help them to reengage.

Responsibilities

- Be present and involved in Kids Ministry services and events
- Be prepared to teach as needed in each age group
- Plan for and prepare for kids ministry services and events
- Engage with families to build relationships
- Prepare for services and events by recruiting, scheduling, and communicating with volunteers
- Attend and contribute to weekly staff meetings on Wednesdays at 9:00 am
- Create a path to help first time guests move into engagement within our church
- Track attendance and follow up with families who are missing

Personal Development

Kids Ministry Resident will spend time developing personal skills to help improve his/her ability to lead others.

- Complete weekly coaching meetings
- Set personal goals and a plan to achieve them

You will be asked to help with projects that are outside of normal operations. Such as:

- Special services (Christmas Eve, Worship Nights, etc.)
- Community Outreach events (Fall Fest, Music Mondays, Camp Discovery, etc.)
